



NZOIA Tertiary Award

This award is aimed at students who have a passion for outdoor instruction and show great potential for further involvement in the industry beyond their studies.

Criteria for the Tertiary Award

The Student:

- Has or will finish their studies in the 2018 year.
- Displays significant potential to be involved in the industry as an instructor in the future.
- Has an understanding of NZOIA and shows interest in being part of a professional body.
- Has demonstrated a strong commitment to gaining a leader qualification/s during their course of study.
- Is outstanding amongst their peers.
- Has demonstrated a commitment to personal outdoor recreation participation.

Applications

- Each tertiary provider/MOU organisation will make their own judgment as to who their successful student is.
- There is one award per tertiary provider that has an MOU with NZOIA.
- Successful students will need to have a brief testimonial (500 words max) written on their behalf, outlining how they meet the criteria. These must be received by NZOIA by the 30th June 2018 and may be published in NZOIA communications.
- The 2018 Tertiary Award prize is one complimentary entry to the 2018 NZOIA National Training Symposium: Full Registration. Travel not included. Please still nominate a student, even if they cannot make the Symposium, as they will still be acknowledged at the Awards dinner and in other correspondence.
- Successful students who are able to attend the Symposium will need to complete an online registration for the Symposium by 1st August 2018. NZOIA will send further instructions to the students regarding to how to complete this.
- The winners will be presented with a certificate at the Symposium Awards Dinner.
