## Scope

## Kayak Instructor Level 1 Profile

The NZOIA Kayak Instructor Level 1 is able to:

- Demonstrate kayaking on class 3 whitewater
- Demonstrate role model kayaking skills on class 2 whitewater
- Lead and manage groups on class 2 whitewater
- Apply effective safety management
- Teach kayak rolling
- Teach flat water kayaking skills
- Teach moving water and river running skills on class 2 whitewater
- Role model accepted environmental practices
- Demonstrate and / or describe cultural and environmental knowledge relating to NZ rivers

#### **Instructional Scope**

The holder of this qualification can organise, instruct and lead kayaking on class 2 whitewater and teach introductory kayaking skills, including rolling, on flatwater to class 2 whitewater.

#### **Pre-requisites**

The NZOIA Kayak Instructor Level 1 will have the following personal kayaking experience:

• No less than 50 river trips on at least 5 different rivers, including at least 20 river trips on class 3 (or above)

A river trip is considered at least 2 hours duration from put in to get out on a recognised section of a river.

In additon to the personal experience outlined above, the NZOIA Kayak Instructor Level 1 will have no less than the following instructional experience:

- 20 sessions teaching rolling
- 15 flat-water teaching sessions
- 15 moving water teaching sessions
- 20 river trip sessions

Instructing experience can include being a co-instructor or assistant instructor.

The NZOIA Kayak Instructor Level 1 will have:

- Attended a NZOIA /WWNZ River Rescue 1 course
- A current First Aid qualification

The NZOIA Kayak Instructor Level 1 will be 20 years old or over.

The pre-requisite experience requirements are minimums, extra days are recommended so that a broad range of variables are experienced.

### Revalidation

The NZOIA Kayak Instructor Level 1 qualification remains valid as long as the holder completes NZOIA's revalidation and registration requirements.

## **Progressing to Instructor Level 2 Qualifications**

As the NZOIA Kayak Instructor Level 1 gains more experience, they can progress to gaining the Level 2 qualification. The steps they can follow include:

- Gaining the experience outlined in the NZOIA Kayak Instructor Level 2 pre-requisites.
- Attending an NZOIA Level 2 training course.
- Attending an NZOIA / WWNZ River Rescue 2 course.
- Working with an NZOIA Level 2 Kayak Instructor.

## Syllabus

### **Technical Competence**

- 1. Demonstrate an understanding of kayaking history and contemporary issues
- 2. Demonstrate the care and correct use of kayaking gear and equipment commonly used in New Zealand
- 3. Demonstrate personal kayaking skills on class 2 and class 3 whitewater
- 4. Demonstrate river rescue skills

### **The Environment**

- 5. Role model accepted environmental practices
- 6. Demonstrate and / or describe cultural and environmental knowledge of NZ rivers

#### **Group Management and Leadership**

- 7. Lead and manage a group kayaking up to and including class 2 whitewater
- 8. Apply effective safety management

#### **Instruction**

- 9. Prepare and deliver teaching sessions
- 10. Teach a pool session
- 11. Teach flat water kayaking skills
- 12. Teach moving water skills
- 13. Teach river running skills
